

Superficial Perivascular Dermatitis

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- 1) Lymphohistiocytic infiltrate
 - Pigmented purpuric dermatitis
 - Viral exanthems
 - Erythrasma
 - Postinflammatory pigmentary alteration
 - Gyrate erythema, superficial
- 2) Mixed-cell infiltrate
 - Lichen sclerosus et atrophicus
 - Urticaria
 - Arthropod reactions, superficial
 - “Itchy red bump” disease
 - Papular eruption of pregnancy
 - Lichen planus
- 3) Sparse infiltrate
 - Tinea versicolor
 - Pitted Keratolysis
 - Mucormycosis

Interface dermatitis

- 1) Vacuolar type
 - Erythema multiforme
 - Graft versus host disease
 - Dermatomyositis
 - Toxic epidermal necrolysis
 - Phototoxic dermatitis
 - Discoid lupus erythematosus (acute)
 - Lichen sclerosus et atrophicus
 - Erythema dyschromicum perstans

2) Lichenoid type

- Lichen planus
- Pityriasis lichenoides
- Porokeratosis
- Lichen nitidus
- Lichenoid purpura

Spongiotic dermatitis

- 1) Without eosinophils
 - Pityriasis rosea
 - Miliaria
 - Stasis dermatitis
 - Seborrheic dermatitis
 - Lichen striatus
- 2) With eosinophils
 - Acute spongiotic dermatitis
 - Scabies
 - Dermatophytosis
 - Incontinentia pigmenti
 - Arthropod reactions

Psoriasiform dermatitis

- 1) Subacute and chronic spongiotic dermatitis
 - Psoriasis
 - Lichen simplex chronicus
 - Pityriasis rubra pilaris
 - Seborrheic dermatitis, chronic
 - Pellagra
 - Lamellar ichthyosis
 - Acrodermatitis enteropathica
